Trinity Sunday also known as Holy Trinity Sunday, honours the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief in the Holy Trinity. The human mind can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, but we can sum it up in the following formula: God is three Persons in one Nature. There is only one God, and the three Persons of God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—are all equally God, and They cannot be divided. God is Trinity. God is relational. We are like God. We are "all connected" as a community of faith, hope and love – a community of justice and peace – a community that hopes to be one family – a community that brings rich and poor together. The Spirit of God is part of that community.
