# **+Second Sunday of Eastertide 8th April Also Called Divine Mercy Sunday**

Today, Sunday 8th April there will be a Holy Hour, in the church, at 3.00pm in honour of The Divine Mercy.

Pope Benedict "the centre of the icon of Christ is the Paschal Mystery: Christ is presented as the Crucified, the risen Lord, the One who will come again and who, here and now, hiddenly reigns over all. Every image of Christ must contain these three essential aspects of the mystery of Christ and, in this sense, must be an image of Easter". The Divine Mercy image has all these three aspects!

The Divine Mercy image is the image of the risen Christ on that first Easter, on the evening of the Resurrection, miraculously appearing there in the Upper Room and bestowing on the Apostles the power of the Holy Spirit to forgive sins. His hand is raised in blessing, he shows them His wounds, and Jesus is looking for their trust. He breathes on them and says "Receive the Holy Spirit, whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, what sins you aid form please let me know. (tel 409843). retain our retained".
