#### **+Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress "Adoremus" - Liverpool 2018**

Between the 7th - 9th September 2018 the bishops of England and Wales are holding a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress in Liverpool. Eucharistic Congresses are gatherings of clergy, religious and laity which promote an awareness of the central place of the Eucharist in the life and mission of the Church. The last International Eucharistic Congress in England was held in 1908 when permission for a public procession of the Blessed Sacrament was refused. Participants will engage in a series of sessions focusing on different dimensions of the Eucharist and the daily celebration and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. This pilgrimage will bring people together from across the dioceses and further the service of the poor and marginalised in our midst. It also aims to provide practical resources to develop the mission of the Church in prayer, contemplation and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Please pray for the Congress.
