### **+Mass Bookings**

If it is your intention to attend Mass, booking is essential. Please book by email: [barry@rcadc.org](mailto:barry@rcadc.org) or by telephoning the parish office: **01446 735051** (option 2), please state which Mass you wish to attend and how many people are attending.

**Update on Booking For Mass: The parish office will be open Tuesday to Friday from 9.00am to 2.00pm to receive bookings for Saturday/Sunday Mass, either by email or telephone. This means that the office is closed, for Mass bookings, from 2.00pm Friday to 9.00am Tuesday. If you have been unable to book a place for Mass please do not turn up on the off chance that there may be a place available as it is important that the guidelines are adhered to, which could lead to disappointment.** The church doors will be open 20 minutes before Mass begins and will be locked as soon as Mass begins. Please follow the stewards instructions as a seating plan & one way system are in place. Please ensure you only sit in the seat that the steward has designated you to. Face Covering are mandatory unless medically exempt. In the event of a fire you would not be expected to follow the one way system, please exit at the nearest safest exit. The toilet facility is available, children must be accompanied to the toilet by an adult.

### **+October Month of the Holy Rosary**

In keeping with tradition we will be celebrating the Rosary during the month of October. The intentions of the rosary will be for the conversion of sinners, for the life of the parish & for the healing of the pandemic. There will be an opportunity for people to make their own private intentions. Please note: the rosary will be recited in church (live stream active) on Tuesdays at 11:15am. Wednesdays, Thursdays & Fridays at 5:15pm (Live stream only).

### **+Fogger Machine Appeal**

We are looking to purchase disinfecting fogger machines for use in our church, these machines can effectively expel a disinfecting spray throughout a building, eradicating the virus. Such machines are used extensively in hotels, restaurants and various commercial settings. The cost for one machine is £276.00. One person using the machine could clean the church in a few minutes. The advantage of the machine is that unlike manual cleaning the spray reaches all areas of the church or area to be cleaned. If you are able to donate there is a donation box next to the weekly collection box as you leave the church. Thank you to all those who have already contributed, so far, we have had a very generous response.

### **+Local Lockdown– Coronavirus**

The vale of Glamorgan has now entered into a 'local lockdown'. The church will remain open for Mass and Confessions as it did prior to the local lockdown. Please follow government guidelines and only attend Mass at St Helen's Parish if you live in the Vale of Glamorgan, please do not travel into the area for Mass if you live outside of the area. Please follow all guidelines in the church as they are in place to protect yourself and others.

### **+Entering & Exiting The Church**

Please note that as of the weekend 17th/18th October there will be a new way in which we enter and exit the church for weekend Masses only. Please enter the Church using the Parish Hall doors, this will enable us to socially distance inside the porch while signing in for Mass. When leaving the church we will continue to leave using the side door through to the Parish Hall and then back out the same door you entered through. The reason that we have changed this procedure is to ensure that in bad weather throughout winter parishioners are not waiting outside the building. As always the stewards will be on hand to guide you.
