# **+Sunday Mass Bookings**

Booking is essential. Please book by email: barry@rcadc.org or by telephoning the parish office: 01446 735051 (option 2), please state which Mass you wish to attend and how many people are attending. Face masks are mandatory unless medically exempt. All Masses and devotions can be live streamed via the parish website: sthelensrcchurch.co.uk.

### **+Changes To Attending Mass**

There has been an important relaxation in the rules regarding who may sit together, bringing places of worship (and other public places) in line with cafes, pubs ect. A group of people may now sit together without maintaining a 2 meter distance from up to 6 different households. Outside of the 6 households it will still be mandatory for you to keep the 2 meter distance and so there is seating in the church that cannot be used. From the weeknd of 23rd/24th July 2021 there will be a need to sign in on entering the church for weekend Masses, Weekday Masses and devotions, by providing your name and contact number, this will assist with track and trace. The one way system, hand sanitising and wearing of face masks are still to be adhered to. In keeping with this the last weekend for booking Masses will be Sat 17th /Sun 18th July, this means that there will be no need to book a place at Mass from the weekend of Sat 23rd/Sun 24th July. The next announcement regarding regulations in Wales is expected on July 15 or 16, to be implemented from July 19.

### **+Distribution Of Holy Communion**

Holy Communion will be distributed to those attending Mass whilst remaining in their seat. Therefore we will no longer exit the church directly after communion. Please follow the stewards guidance.
