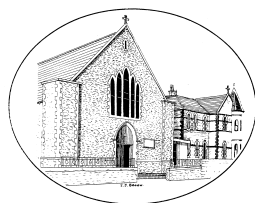

It has been confirmed that the Holy Father has accepted the resignation of Archbishop George as Archbishop of Cardiff having reached the canonical age of 75. He has accepted "nunc pro tunc" meaning Archbishop George remains in situ until Pope Francis announces the 8th Archbishop of Cardiff. Ask your MP to vote against abortion up to birth. The abortion lobby, led by the UK's largest abortion provider, BPAS, has worked with Diana Johnson MP to bring forward an amendment to hijack the Police, Crime, Sentencing and Courts Bill to introduce abortion on demand, for any reason, up to birth to England and Wales. This would be the single biggest change to abortion legislation since 1967 and would leave England and Wales with one of the most extreme abortion laws in the world. We are expecting that this radical proposal will be voted on by MPs this Monday. The First World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly will be held on Sunday 25th July. Pope Francis has decided to institute a Church-wide celebration of a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Starting this year, it will be held on the fourth Sunday of July, close to the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. The Holy Father explained he has done this because "grandparents are often forgotten, and we forget this wealth of preserving roots and passing on" what the elderly have received. He emphasized the importance of grandparents and grandchildren getting to know one another, because "as the prophet Joel says, grandparents seeing their grandchildren dream," while "young people, drawing strength from their grandparents, will go forward and prophesy." The 10:30am Mass on Sunday 25th July will be for the intention of All grandparents and the elderly of our parish community. May we pray with them and for them.
