+St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross

On August 9 the Catholic Church remembers St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, also known as St. Edith Stein. St. Teresa converted from Judaism to Catholicism in the course of her work as a philosopher, and later entered the Carmelite Order.

Edith Stein was born on October 12, 1891 – a date that coincided with her family's celebration of Yom Kippur, the Jewish “day of atonement.” Edith's father died when she was just two years old, and she gave up the practice of her Jewish faith as an adolescent.

St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross died in the concentration camp at Auschw on August 9, 1942. Blessed St. John Paul II canonized her in 1998, and proclaimed her a co-patroness of Europe the next year.
