+Pilgrimage Of Relics: St. John Lloyd & St. Philip Evans

Below are some of the dates and preliminary venues for the forthcoming pilgrimage of the relics of St. John Lloyd and St. Philip Evans to the Dioceses of Cardiff and Menevia. The relics are being loaned by Stonyhurst College and the climax of the pilgrimage will be Mass at Cardiff Castle in the cell where our martyrs were imprisoned before their martyrdom. The Mass will be followed by a procession to the place of execution in what is now called Richmond Road.
