+October Month Of The Rosary

The month of October is dedicated to the holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7). The best way to celebrate the month is, of course, to pray the Rosary. According to an account by fifteenth-century Dominican, Alan de la Roch, Mary appeared to St. Dominic in 1206 after he had been praying and doing severe penances because of his lack of success in combating the Albigensian heresy. Mary praised him for his valiant fight against the heretics and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon, explained its uses and efficacy, and told him to preach it to others. "Since the prayers of the Rosary come from such excellent sources — from Our Lord Himself, from inspired Scripture, and from the Church — it is not surprising that the Rosary is so dear to our Blessed Mother and so powerful with heaven.

During the Month of October the Rosary will be recited after all weekday Masses.

+Prisoners' Sunday – 10th October 2021

Prisoners' Sunday marks the first day of the ecumenical Prisons Week, a week of prayer which has been raising awareness of issues faced by those affected by the criminal justice system. Founded in 1975, for over forty years, Prisoners Week has prepared prayer literature to

enable the Christian community to pray for the needs of all those affected by prisons: prisoners and their families, victims of crime and their communities, those working in the criminal justice system and the many people who are involved in caring for those affected by crime on the inside and outside of prisons. Below are some of the dates and preliminary venues for the forthcoming pilgrimage of the relics of St. John Lloyd and St. Philip Evans to the Dioceses of Cardiff and Menevia. The relics are being loaned by Stonyhurst College and the climax of the pilgrimage will be Mass at Cardiff Castle in the cell where our martyrs were imprisoned before their martyrdom. The Mass will be followed by a procession to the place of execution in what is now called Richmond Road. The pilgrimage will be a great Act of Thanksgiving and Witness to those who gave their lives for the Faith. Further details of the pilgrimage may be obtained from Fr.
