+Fr Pat's Retirement Celebrations

As announced some weeks ago Fr Pat will be retiring and celebrating his last Mass as Parish Priest on Sunday 24th July at 10:30am.

Following Mass there will be refreshments in the Parish Hall. The hall will be open for parishioners from 12 noon until 4:00pm. Parishioners are invited to attended for some of that time, this will allow others to attend without the hall becoming over occupied.

There is no need to book, please just turn up on the day. At all Masses on the weekend's of 10th and 17th July there will be a collection for Fr Pat which will be presented to him at the celebration.

There will be a celebration for Fr Pat's retirement on Friday 7th October. The celebration will begin with Mass at St Helen's at 5:00pm, the Mass will be open to everyone. Following Mass there will be a reception at Cottrell Park Golf Club, this will include a 2 Course meal. The price of this per person is £20.00 and does not include transport. If you wish to attend the reception at Cottrell park, spaces are still available please take a form from the back of the church and return it as soon as possible. **The closing date for this is 10th July.**

†Peters Pence Retiring Collection

Peter's Pence is the name given to the financial support offered by the faithful to the Holy Father as a sign of their sharing in the concern of the Successor of Peter for the many different needs of the Universal Church and for the relief of those most in need.

The offerings of the faithful are intended to support the activities of the Holy Father for the whole Universal Church. These activities are carried out by the Holy See. The Pope, as Pastor of the universal Church, is concerned both with the needs of evangelization (spiritual, educational, justice, communication, political charity, diplomatic activity, etc.) and with the material needs of poor dioceses, religious institutes and faithful in serious difficulties (the poor, children, the elderly, the marginalized, victims of wars and natural disasters; special aid to Bishops or Dioceses in need, Catholic education, aid to refugees and migrants, etc.).

There will be a retiring collection at **all Masses this Weekend** to assist the Holy Father in his mission.

This Saturday 2nd July at the 6.30pm Mass Marilyn Frayling will be presented with the Archdiocesan Medal in recognition of her long service to the Church. There will be light refreshments in the hall following the Mass. This Mass will also be live streamed.
